Forgive us for our doubts. Help us to place our trust in you, Lord Jesus. / Help us to fix our eyes on you and on the ministries to which you have called us. / For we ask these things in Jesus name. It is indeed right, it is our duty and our joy, at all times and in all places / to give you thanks and praise, holy Father, heavenly King,/ almighty and eternal God, through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord./

For he is your living Word; through him you have created all things from the beginning,/ and formed us in your own image. who, in the same night that he was betrayed, took bread and gave you thanks;/ he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying:/ Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me./

In the same way, after supper he took the cup and gave you thanks; he gave it to them, saying: / Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. / Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. /

Therefore, heavenly Father, we remember his offering of himself made once for all upon the cross; / we proclaim his mighty resurrection and glorious ascension; we look for the coming of your kingdom, / and with this bread and this cup we make the memorial of Christ your Son our Lord. /

Great is the mystery of faith:
**Christ has died. Christ is risen.
Christ will come again. /**

Accept through him, our great high priest, this our sacrifice of thanks and praise, / and as we eat and drink these holy gifts in the presence of your divine majesty, / renew us by your Spirit, inspire us with your love and unite us in the body of your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. /

Through him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, / with all who stand before you in earth and heaven, we worship you, Father almighty, in songs of everlasting praise: /

Blessing and honour and glory and power be yours for ever and ever. Amen. //
