NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Authorisation is required to adapt the existing kitchen and nearby area situated in the church hall as stated below.

This will include the purchase of new kitchen equipment.

The schedule of work:

1. Extend the width of the kitchen by approximately one metre by moving the internal wall and hatch further into the hall. The hatch needs to be in a central position in the new wall.
2. Remove the wall between the kitchen and store room 2. The door into store room 2 will now be removed to become another access to the kitchen.
3. Remove the wall between store room 2 and the caretaker's cupboard, remove the wall between the gents' toilet and the caretaker's cupboard and also the removal of the door to the caretaker's cupboard. This means that the caretaker's cupboard will no longer exist.
4. To strip all sanitary ware from the gents' toilet and cap off all services in order to make the toilet into a storage area for the kitchen and The Pantry.
5. The door from store room 2 to be used as the access door from the hall to the storage area and the kitchen.
6. To purchase and install the new kitchen equipment as per quotations from CKS.

This will create sufficient space for both volunteers and staff to work safely and there will be sufficient facilities to prepare hot and cold food. It will give us a fully equipped professional kitchen which we can hire out for community events.
