***Introduction**

***Confession**

Let us open our lives to God's searching gaze: / **Dear God of mercy and compassion; we acknowledge that we are not all that we would like to be; / we carry wounds and regrets, both of our own design, and what we have received from others. / We acknowledge our failings and weaknesses, our lack of faith and our selfishness. We ask you to heal us. /**

Of all our sin, **forgive us, O God. /**

In all our weakness, **strengthen us, O God. /**

From all our diseases, **heal us, O God. Amen.//**

Assurance of God's Forgiveness

May the God of love and power, forgive us and free us from our sins, / heal and strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to new life in Christ our Lord. **Amen.//**

***Special Prayer for Today**

Lord of all power and might, the author and giver of all good things: / graft in our hearts the love of your name, increase in us true religion, nourish us with all goodness, / and of your great mercy keep us in the same; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, / who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.//**

***An Affirmation of Faith**

Using words from Philippians chapter 2, let us affirm our faith in Jesus Christ the Son of God: /

Though he was divine, he did not cling to equality with God, but made himself nothing. / Taking the form of a slave, he was born in human likeness. He humbled himself and was obedient to death, / even the death of the cross. Therefore God has raised him on high, and given him the name above every name: / that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, and every voice proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, / to the glory of God the Father. Amen.//

Thank you, Lord, for making us yours and
caring for us as a good shepherd cares for the
sheep./ Help us to recognise Jesus in those
who are sick or needy,/ and serve him humbly
by giving to others in gratitude for what you
have given us by serving them. Amen.//

***The Eucharistic Prayer F**

The Lord is here. His Spirit is with us./

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord./

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise./

You are worthy of our thanks and praise, Lord
God of truth, for by the breath / of your mouth
you have spoken your word, and all things have
come into being./

You fashioned us in your image and placed us in
the garden of your delight./ Though we chose
the path of rebellion you would not abandon
your own./

Again and again you drew us into your covenant
of grace. You gave your people / the law and
taught us by your prophets to look for your
reign of justice, mercy and peace./

As we watch for the signs of your kingdom on
earth, we echo the song / of the angels in
heaven, evermore praising you and saying:/

**Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might, /
heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest./**

Lord God, you are the most holy one,
enthroned in splendour and light,/ yet in the
coming of your Son Jesus Christ you reveal
the power of your love / made perfect in our
human weakness.

Amen. Lord, we believe./

Embracing our humanity, Jesus showed us the
way of salvation;/ loving us to the end, he gave
himself to death for us; dying for his own,/ he set
us free from the bonds of sin, that we might rise/
and reign with him in glory.

Amen. Lord, we believe./

On the night he gave up himself for us all he
took bread and gave you thanks;/ he broke it
and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take, eat;/
this is my body which is given for you; do this
in remembrance of me.

Amen. Lord, we believe./

In the same way, after supper he took the cup
and gave you thanks;/ he gave it to them,
saying: Drink this, all of you; this is my blood / of
the new covenant which is shed for you and for
many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often
as you drink it,/ in remembrance of me.

Amen. Lord, we believe./

Therefore we proclaim the death that he
suffered on the cross,/ we celebrate his
resurrection, his bursting from the tomb, we
rejoice that he reigns / at your right hand on
high and we long for his coming in glory.

Amen. Come Lord Jesus./

As we recall the one, perfect sacrifice of our
redemption, Father,/ by your Holy Spirit let
these gifts of your creation be to us / the
body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ; form
us into the likeness of Christ / and make us a
perfect offering in your sight.

Amen. Come Holy Spirit./

Look with favour on your people and in your mercy hear the cry of our hearts. / Bless the earth, heal the sick, let the oppressed go free / and fill your Church with power from on high. **Amen. Come Holy Spirit. /**

Gather your people from the ends of the earth to feast with all your saints / at the table in your kingdom, where the new creation is brought to perfection in Jesus Christ our Lord; /

by whom, and with whom, and in whom, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, / all honour and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.

Amen. //

****The Lord's Prayer***

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, / your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. / Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. / Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. / For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever. Amen. //

****Breaking of the Bread***

We break this bread to share in the body of Christ. / Though we are many, we are one body, because we all share in one bread. /

Giving of Communion

Draw near with faith. Receive the body of our Lord Jesus Christ / which he gave for you, and his blood which he shed for you. / Eat and drink in remembrance that he died for you, and feed on him in your hearts by faith with thanksgiving. //

We receive communion

****Prayer after Communion***

God of all compassion, by the dying and rising of Christ you restore us to yourself and enfold us in your love. / May we who have been refreshed with the bread of life and the cup of salvation be renewed by your healing Spirit / and made ready to serve you as your disciples; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. //
