***Confession**

There is nothing which can separate us from the love of God. / So let us confess our failings, and faults so we may be touched by his healing power. /

We want to touch the hem of your garment, O God: forgive us for being afraid to touch those

who come to us for hope. / We want to love the whole world: forgive us, Lord, for ignoring our neighbour. / We long for peace: forgive us, Lord, for the pain we inflict on our own families and friends. / We want to share with those we love and like: forgive us, loving Lord, for walking past those who need you most. / This we ask in Jesus name. Amen. /

Assurance of God's Forgiveness

Jesus sacrificial death on the cross has brought healing and forgiveness / to all who believe in Him. So let us rejoice as we feel the touch of Christ on our hearts. **Amen. //**

***Special Prayer for Today**

O God, the protector of all who trust in you, without whom nothing is strong, / nothing is holy: increase and multiply upon us your mercy; / that with you as our ruler and guide we may so pass through things temporal / that we lose not our hold on things eternal; grant this, heavenly Father, / for our Lord Jesus Christ's sake, who is alive and reigns with you, / in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen. //**

Paul challenged the church at Corinth to recognize their abundance, that they might share with those in need. / God calls us to give out of our bounty, that all might have enough to live on. /

God of all goodness and grace, receive the gifts we offer; / and grant that our lives may give you glory and praise; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen. //

**The Eucharistic Prayer G*

The Lord be with you.

And also with you. /

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them to the Lord. /

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

It is right to give thanks and praise. /

Blessed are you, Lord God, our light and our salvation; to you be glory and praise for ever. / From the beginning you have created all things / and all your works echo the silent music of your praise. / In the fullness of time you made us in your image, the crown of all creation. / You give us breath and speech, that with angels and archangels / and all the powers of heaven we may find a voice to sing your praise: /

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. / Hosanna in the highest. /

How wonderful the work of your hands, O Lord. / As a mother tenderly gathers her children, you embraced a people as your own. / When they turned away and rebelled your love remained steadfast. / From them you raised up Jesus our Saviour, born of Mary, / to be the living bread, in whom all our hungers are satisfied. / He offered his life for sinners, and with a love stronger than death he opened wide his arms on the cross. /

On the night before he died, he came to supper with his friends / and, taking bread, he gave you thanks. He broke it and gave it to them, saying: / Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me. /

At the end of supper, taking the cup of wine, he gave you thanks, and said: / Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant / which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. /

Jesus Christ is Lord:

Lord, by your cross and resurrection you have set us free. / You are the Saviour of the world. /

Father, we plead with confidence his sacrifice made once for all upon the cross; / we remember his dying and rising in glory, and we rejoice that he intercedes for us at your right hand. /

Pour out your Holy Spirit as we bring before you these gifts of your creation; / may they be for us the body and blood of your dear Son. /

As we eat and drink these holy things in your presence, form us / in the likeness of Christ, and build us into a living temple to your glory. /

Bring us at the last with all the saints to the vision of that eternal splendour for which you have created us; / through Jesus Christ, our Lord, by whom, with whom, and in whom, / with all who stand before you in earth and heaven, we worship you, Father almighty, in words of everlasting praise: /

Blessing and honour and glory and power be yours for ever and ever. Amen. //

****The Lord's Prayer***

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, / your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. / Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. / Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. / For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours now and for ever. Amen. //

****Breaking of the Bread***

Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup, / we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes. /

Giving of Communion

Draw near with faith. Receive the body of our Lord Jesus Christ / which he gave for you, and his blood which he shed for you. / Eat and drink in remembrance that he died for you, and feed on him in your hearts by faith with thanksgiving. //

****Prayer after Communion***

Eternal God, comfort of the afflicted and healer of the broken, / you have fed us at the table of life and hope: teach us the ways of gentleness and peace, / that all the world may acknowledge the kingdom of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen. /**

Blessing

Christ's touch has healed you. God's love has restored you. The Spirit goes with you. / So may the blessing of God almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, / be among you and remain with you always. **Amen. /**
